TAKE CARE OF WEAR-AND-TEAR AND SERVICE ITEMS IN ONE GO

Vehicle parts suffer wear-and-tear and will need replacement or repair as time goes on. Take care of this, and get peace of mind while enjoying your vehicle with a KIA Maintenance Plan.

WHAT IS A KIA MAINTENANCE PLAN?

This plan covers everything that is included in a **Service Plan**, plus the replacement or repair of specific wear-and-tear parts, when necessary. All maintenance repairs must be performed by an ***OEM** approved repair facility, over a specific period of time or specific distance travelled – whichever happens first.

** OEM is the original equipment manufacturer of a new vehicle, who manufactures the original parts and components used during the construction of your vehicle. In certain countries, the OEM is often represented by an Importer of a specific brand of vehicle.*

WHAT IS A KIA SERVICE PLAN?

This plan offers you a convenient way of budgeting so that you can spend less time worrying about the costs of taking care of your vehicle and more time enjoying the open road.

This plan pays for **OEM** specified aspects of the recommended **OEM** service schedule.

All service repairs must be performed by an **OEM** approved repair facility, over a certain period of time or specific distance travelled, whichever happens first.

WHAT IS WEAR-AND-TEAR?

Wear-and-tear is a term used to describe the gradual physical deterioration of various parts of the vehicle. Wear-and-tear happens naturally and is inevitable as a result of normal use and ageing.
